## THE OLD CYTRINGANIANS

## RULES

1. The name of the Association shall be called: 'The Old Cytringanians'.
2. All ladies and gentlemen, who have attended Kettering Grammar School and its successor school Kettering Boys School, as pupils, shall be eligible to become members. All ladies and gentlemen who have been members of the Teaching Staff or the Governing Body shall be honorary members. All applications for membership shall be reported by the secretary at the next following meeting of the Committee, who shall have power to reject any application without reason given. The Committee shall have power to expel any member whose conduct is undesirable or detrimental.
3. The Subscription shall be as follows: Life Members $£ 10.00$
4. Upon payment of the subscription, each member shall be entitled to receive one copy of the current rules.
5. The General Fund, may be invested in any investment authorised by law for investment by the Committee.
6. An Annual General Meeting shall be held upon a date to be fixed by the Committee, and in any case not later than 15 months after the previous Annual General Meeting. At the Annual General Meeting the Officers and Committee for the ensuing year shall be elected.
7. An Extraordinary General Meeting may be called at any time by Resolution of the Committee, or by the Secretary at the written request of not less than 20 members who have paid their subscriptions.
8. At least seven clear days notice shall be given to every member of all General Meetings and, in the case of an Extraordinary General Meeting the business to be transacted shall be specified on the notice convening the Meeting.
9. All business shall be transacted by the Officers and Committee, other than the following which will require a resolution passed at a General Meeting:
(a) Alteration of Rules. Notice of a proposed alteration of Rules shall be given to the Secretary at least 28 days before the date of a General Meeting and the proposed alteration shall be specified on the notice convening the Meeting
(b) Adoption of Annual Accounts.
(c) Allocation of surplus General Fund.
(d) Withdrawal of monies from the General Fund.
10. The Officers and Committee shall consist of:
(a) Honorary Life President, selected by the Commitee.
(b) Chairman.
(c) Secretary.
(d) Treasurer.
(e) Not more than a total of 10 committee ladies and gentleman.

A quorum shall be six for any Committee meeting.
11. The Committee may elect any member to fill a casual vacancy in the committee or its officers until the next Annual General Meeting or may co-opt one or more members for special purposes.
12. The colours shall be black, white and red and shall be available to members in such form as the Committee may from time to time determine.
